






Portfolio breakdown

Delta Adj Exposure % Nav: method of measuring the market risk exposure of a portfolio that includes derivatives like options



Management commentary—May 2025

The Compounders strategy performed well, driven by the strong contribution of INTERACTIVE BROKERS GROUP (+0.96%), supported by a growing global customer base. Also excellent performance by PRYSMIAN SPA (+0.46%), which benefited from continued expansion in the electricity infrastructure sector, and AIA GROUP LTD (+0.50%), boosted by solid operating results in the Asian market. **COMPOUNDERS** Positive contributions were also made by SCHNEIDER ELECTRIC SE (+0.37%), DE'LONGHI SPA (+0.32%), SIEMENS AG-REG +3.68% (+0.32%) and NOVO NORDISK (+0.23%), the latter thanks to robust growth in the pharmaceutical segment. Also in evidence were DINO POLSKA SA (+0.21%) and CTS EVENTIM (+0.19%), the latter buoyed by good performance in the live events market. Slightly negative was REPLY SPA (-0.22%), due to profit-taking after a solid performance in previous months. The Macro Gold strategy experienced a slight correction, reflecting the stabilization of the gold price after the **MACRO GOLD** highs touched in previous months. In particular, major ETCs on physical gold such as INVESCO PHYSICAL GOLD ETC (-0.03%) and ISHARES PHYSICAL GOLD ETC (-0.02%) retraced slightly, in the absence of any significant new infla--0.05% tionary or geopolitical shocks. In May, we reduced net exposure to the dollar while simultaneously increasing EUR via forwards, in line with our bea-**OVERLAY** rish structural view on the USD. To protect the portfolio against contrarian scenarios, we purchased a EUR/USD put strike 1.085 expiring July 24 as a tail hedge. In addition, the exposure to HKD was fully hedged, benefiting from a posi-+0.92% The solid performance of the Macro Equity strategy in May was mainly driven by exposure to the Greek sector, with EURO-BANK ERGASIAS SERVICES (+0.56%) and PIRAEUS FINANCIAL HOLDINGS (+0.97%) benefiting from solid financial data and a favorable economic environment in Greece. The European banking sector remained neutral during the month (EURO STOXX BANK Jun25 and UNICREDIT SPA unchan-**MACRO EQUITY** ged), while the energy component made a slight positive contribution with OCCIDENTAL PETROLEUM +0.11%. We then increased our position on uranium during the month through the purchase of GLOBAL X URANIUM UCITS Global ETF (-0.03%) +0.95% and with YELLOW CAKE PLC (-0.05%). Net exposure to the uranium theme thus increased, buoyed by the Trump administration's decision to actively support the nuclear industry, effectively removing the bear case scenario. In contrast, Brazil's performance was negative, where BANCO DO BRASIL S.A. (-0.61%) was affected by local political and macroeconomic uncertainties. The Special Situations strategy ended the month with a positive performance, driven by the equity component. In particular, WEBUILD SPA (+0.77%) supported by new infrastructure orders in Europe and positive sentiment related to public investment in the construction sector. IVANHOE ELECTRIC INC / US (+0.22%) also made a positive contribution; GLENCORE SPECIAL SITUA-PLC (+0.04%) recovered some of the losses of previous months thanks to the rebound in commodity prices, a position we **TIONS** closed at the end of the month. On the downside was ALIBABA GROUP HOLDING LTD (-0.21%), weighed down by lingering +1.38% regulatory concerns and a slowdown in consumption in China. During the month we took profits on the stock, with position reduction. On the banking segment, UNICREDIT SPA (+0.55%) sustained performance thanks to solid quarterly results and the continuation of a favorable shareholder remuneration policy.
