Destination Dynamic Income Total Return Fund is a **fixed-income**, **multi-strategy portfolio**. The portfolio has a benchmark-free!, **high-conviction** approach to bond selection anchored in fundamental valuations, combining top-down and bottom-up approaches. By allocating to **proprietary strategies** rather than asset classes, the portfolio focuses on identifying **idiosyncratic opportunities**. An important goal of the portfolio is to achieve true **diversification**, recognizing time and correlation as key diversifiers.









Portfolio breakdown



Portfolio Management Commentary—June 2025

Macro 0.00%	The Curve Steepening segment (0.02%) had several key movers. On the positive end there was the US 5YR NOTE (CBT) Sep25 (+0.16%) and the US 2YR NOTE (CBT) Sep25 (+0.14%). On the negative end we had the US 10yr Ultra Fut Sep25 (-0.21%) and the US ULTRA BOND CBT Sep25 (-0.12%). The slight negative performance of the Curve Steepening segment was balanced out by the Rates Global segment (+0.02%) which saw slight movements in the NOTA DO TESOURO NACIONAL (+0.03%) and MEX BONOS DESARR FIX RT (-0.03%).
Income	The Income strategy performed positively when denominated in local currency (+1.14%), with the best performing segments being Financials (+0.62%) and Energy (+0.21). However, the strategy had a negative overall performance, mainly driven by the FX exposure to USD, which weakened by 3.7% affecting all our USD credit positions. This loss was fully recovered in the FX Overlay strategy.
-0.24%	We continued rotating portfolios by trimming exposure to bonds trading at tight spreads and reallocating into segments where we still see some residual upside, particularly in the ATI market and, more broadly, in financials. Our focus remains on idiosyncratic situations with compelling risk/reward profiles and tactical opportunities driven by volatility since spreads remain tight in developed markets and offer limited attractiveness in EM beta.
Special Situations 0.00%	The Special Situations strategy saw very slight positive and negative movements in certain positions, which balanced each other out, ending the month flat.
Overlay +1.63%	In June, we continued to reduce our net exposure to the dollar (-5.00%), while simultaneously increasing EUR via forwards, in line with our structural bearish view on the USD. This view is shared with our view of the HKD, which we continue to short, assuming the USD/HKD peg remains intact, allowing us to express the same bearish view on the dollar with a significantly lower negative carry. This contributed to an overall positive performance in Overlay FX (+1.74%), the biggest contributor to this month's performance of this Strategy. This view allowed us to recover losses on our USD credit positions in other strategies, mainly the Income Strategy. On the negative side, the Overlay Credit segment (-0.34%) was brought down by ITXEX543 CDS (-0.34%).
